



When preparing for the treatment of **Bedbugs**, by Gath's Pest Patrol be sure to abide by the instructions below, **BEFORE** arrival of technician

- Remove all bedding. Please **do not** move or elevate mattress and box spring. If this is done it could cause the bedbugs to move to other locations and make successful treatment harder.
- Remove linens from bed, wash and then dry on high heat for 30 minutes. Once dry, bag up and seal until treatment has been applied and allotted time for product to dry has been reached.
- All luggage, suitcases, or gym bags should be emptied and left open for inspection and treatment.
- Remove belongings from dressers, bookshelves, night stands, shelves, and tables. Make sure items are accessible to the technician to turn over and inspect. **Do Not Stack.**
- Entertainment centers need to be cleared of movies, books, remotes etc, the TV itself may remain but, all else needs to be cleared.
- Clear items from the baseboards, **at least 2 feet** away, because they will be treated as well. Clear any debris from the floor.
- If you have fish, cover the tank with plastic. For other pets be sure to cover their supplies with plastic as well.
- Remove everything from under your bed. Throw out any cardboard. Cardboard makes for the perfect home for bugs.
- Bathtubs/showers and sinks may be used as a staging place for your things during the treatment.
- **You and your pets must be out of the home for 4 hours.**

- Please allow up to 4 weeks for the treatment to become effective. If you see activity after the allotted 4 weeks contact Gath's Pest Patrol to determine if a follow up appointment is necessary
- **Special Note:** If during the treatment the technician finds any items untreatable or saturated with infestation we will advise that they be permanently removed from the residence.
